Children's Behavior Policy

MOMS Club® activities are meant to be enjoyable and safe events for both parents and children. MOMS Club® respects parenting differences but expects that all children behave appropriately at MOMS Club® activities. Unacceptable behaviors include, but are not limited to:

- Hitting, hitting with objects
- Scratching
- Kicking
- Biting
- Spitting
- Hair pulling
- Destroying property
- Inappropriate touch
- Overly suggestive behavior

In the unfortunate event that these behaviors occur during MOMS Club® activities, the child's mother should remove her from the immediate area and do so in a reasonable tone of voice so as not to further disrupt or alarm others in the group. The child's mother will be expected to keep an especially diligent watch over the child if an attempt to inflict harm on another child is made, whether that attempt is intentional or not. If the child attempts the behavior a second time at the same activity, the mother must remove the child from the activity for the day. If the child returns to another MOMS Club® function and demonstrates the same negative behavior the mother must immediately remove the child and cannot return to a MOMS Club® activity until the child stops the negative behavior altogether.

Moms Behavior Policy

MOMS Club® is here to support mothers who choose to stay at home with their children. We support all mothers and recognize that there are many different parenting styles and personalities in our club. To ensure a safe, supportive atmosphere, we ask the following of all members:

1. You are responsible for your children at all MOMS Club® functions. If you cannot supervise them all, please talk to other members ahead of the event to see if they can lend a hand.
2. When disciplining your children, please speak in a quiet voice or remove the children from the area. Loud voices and yelling are upsetting to

General Guidelines

Illness Guidelines

All moms need to be sure their child(ren) are well when attending a MOMS Club function. We must take a conservative route to ensure the safety of our pregnant members, infants, children and moms. Please do not bring your child to ANY MOM Club® function if...

- They have run a fever of 100.4 or higher within the last 24 hours.
- They have had vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours.
- They have exhibited any symptoms of any childhood communicable diseases (chickenpox, measles, mumps, whooping cough, swine flu, etc).
- They have a common cold with discolored (green or yellow) nasal discharge.
- They have pink eye (conjunctivitis) or other contagious eye infection.
- They have a sore throat.
- They have croup.
- They have an undiagnosed rash or skin infection.
- They have suspected mononucleosis.
- They have had an inoculation or vaccination of a live virus within 48 hours. (MMR, Chickenpox, or Polio)

Please keep our infants, children and other moms safe by following these simple health regulations. If your child has a potentially life threatening communicable disease including but not limited to AIDS/HIV, Hepatitis A,B, or C, MRSA or SARS please use your best judgment in attending events.

4. You are responsible for reading and following the by-laws of the Club at MOMS Club®, including general by-laws, the Children’s Behavior Policy, Illness Policy, and this policy.
5. To ensure the comfort of moms from all economic and cultural backgrounds, we ask that all members follow the above guidelines. In the unfortunate event that these guidelines are not followed, the witnessing party shall contact a member of the Executive Board. The Executive Board will discuss the issue with the member(s) involved and has the authority to impose penalties as follows:
 - First Offense—verbal warning
 - Second Offense—written warning
 - Third Offense within one calendar year—The member will be allowed the opportunity to state her case before the Executive Board and a vote will be made concerning her membership. This may result in the member losing her membership in the MOMS Club® and forfeiting her dues.
